

Terms And Conditions of Hire

- i). Omni Recycling Limited cannot, and will not, be held responsible or liable for any damage caused if the hirer requests the driver to take the vehicle off of the Public Highway to deliver/position the skip in a location requested by the hirer (or their representatives).
- ii). Omni Recycling Limited will not be liable for any loss or damage caused by failure to supply, or for any delay in supply.
- iii). Omni Recycling Limited reserves the right to charge the customer as a result of a late cancellation, by way of a wasted journey charge of £75.00+VAT.
- iv). The hirer shall ensure that the skip is not overloaded by weight or by volume at the point of collection. All skips should be loaded so that they are not filled higher than the top of its sides. Omni Recycling Limited reserves the right to refuse to collect overloaded skips and any costs incurred due to unsafe loads/overloading (including wasted journeys) will be passed onto the hirer. Additional charges may also be levied.
- v). The lighting of fires in or near skips is strictly prohibited. The hirer will be liable for any loss or damage to the skip container (excluding fair wear and tear) during the term of the skip hire period and will be charged the current purchase price of the skip should it be lost or stolen whilst on the customer's site. Once a skip has been placed, it shall not be repositioned without prior consent from Omni Recycling Limited. Moving skips on site could result in the inability to collect skip or damage to the skip.
- vi). The responsibility for the skip remains with the hirer until collected by an Omni Recycling Limited vehicle. Any skips which are removed, lost or stolen whilst in the control of the hirer will be charged at full and new replacement value.
- vii). Omni Recycling Limited reserves the right to refuse any materials which it considers to be objectionable or unsuitable for deposit on the company's premises.
- viii). Skips can only be placed on the public highway by prior arrangement with Omni Recycling Limited. A permit to site a skip on the public highway, including footpaths, is required from the relevant local authority. Omni Recycling Limited can arrange the relevant permits to deposit a skip on the highway with the relevant local authority and a charge will be made to recover the cost of the permit. Charges vary based upon the rate set by the administering local authority. It is the hirer's responsibility to make sure that all cones and lights are in place in line with the Highways Act 1980.
- ix). The maximum skip hire period is 14 days. It is the responsibility of the hirer to request the collection within this time frame. Failure to do so will result in an unannounced collection.
